The STM is Montréal's bus and métro (subway) network which offers a variety of affordable transit passes valid for individual trips, one day, three days, an unlimited weekend, and more. Fares are free for children under 6 accompanied by an adult with a valid transit fare.

- Sunday to Friday, 5:30 AM to 1AM*
